Waller County 9-1-1 Addressing maps and maintains addresses for Waller County. These addresses are used by all emergency responders when a 9-1-1 call is placed. They are also the mailing addresses for most residents of unincorporated areas. We work closely with Waller County Sheriff Department, U.S. Postal Service, Waller County Commissioners Court, Waller County Appraisal District, and other local services.

In the event of an emergency it is critical that dispatchers and responders have the most up to date information to locate and provide the best service to callers. The physical location is just the tip of the iceberg of needed information. Responders need to know if there is a locked gate at the entrance of your property, who to call for access, gate code/combination, if there is more than one residence on the property, etc. If you choose to provide the 9-1-1 Coordinator with additional information to help dispatch and emergency responders when a 9-1-1 call is placed, please contact the Waller County 9-1-1 Addressing Coordinator via phone or in person.
