BE IT REMEMBERED that on this the 23rd day of September, 2015, the Commissioners' Court of Waller County, Texas met in Regular Session at its regular meeting place in the Waller County Courthouse in Hempstead, Texas with the following members of said Court Present:

- John Amsler, Commissioners, Pct. #1

And the Court being duly opened, ^{Judge} ~~Commissioner~~ Carbett "Trey" J. Duhon III, made a motion that the total tax rate of \$.654806 be adopted as the 2015 Tax Rate.

THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE.

THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 8.00 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$ -29.81

This total tax rate shall be levied as follows:

There shall be levied and collected upon all taxable property in Waller County for the year 2015, for the use of the County, except the first Three Thousand (\$3,000.00) value of residential homestead, an ad valorem tax for maintenance and operations of \$.034436 on each \$100.00 worth of taxable property so assessed to be credited to the Farm-to-Market Roads of Waller County, Texas.

There shall be levied and collected upon all taxable property in Waller County for the year 2015, for the use of the County, an ad valorem tax for maintenance and operations of \$.603741 on each \$100.00 worth of taxable property so assessed to be credited to the General Fund of Waller County, Texas.

There shall be levied and collected upon all taxable property in Waller County for the year 2015, for the use of the County, an ad valorem tax for interest and sinking of \$.016629 on

each \$100.00 worth of taxable property so assessed to be credited to the Debt Fund of Waller County, Texas.


It shall be noted that Waller County grants a \$25,000.00 homestead exemption to persons who are sixty-five (65) year of age or older or who are disabled persons as has been previously allowed.

It shall be noted that Waller County grants an exemption of twenty percent (20%) of the appraised value of the residence homestead of Waller County residents in accordance with Tax Code Sec. 11.13(n), as amended. If this percentage produces an exemption of less than \$5,000.00 when applied to a particular residence homestead, the individual is entitled to an exemption of \$5,000.00 of the appraised value.


