**BE IT REMEMBERED** that on this the 17th day of September, 2014, the Commissioners' Court of Waller County, Texas met in Regular Session at its regular meeting place in the Waller County Courthouse in Hempstead, Texas with the following members of said Court Present:

- Glenn Beckendorff, County Judge
- John Amsler, Commissioners, Pct. #1
- Frank Pokluda, Commissioners, Pct. #2
- Jeron Barnett, Commissioner, Pct. #3
- Stan Kitzman, Commissioner, Pct. #4

And the Court being duly opened, Commissioner Pokluda, made a motion that the total tax rate of \$.686944 be adopted as the 2014 Tax Rate.

**THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE.**

**THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 3.79 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$ 24.39.**

This total tax rate shall be levied as follows:

There shall be levied and collected upon all taxable property in Waller County for the year 2014, for the use of the County, except the first Three Thousand (\$3,000.00) value of residential homestead, an ad valorem tax for maintenance and operations of \$.036194 on each \$100.00 worth of taxable property so assessed to be credited to the Farm-to-Market Roads of Waller County, Texas.

There shall be levied and collected upon all taxable property in Waller County for the year 2014, for the use of the County, an ad valorem tax for maintenance and operations of \$.631797 on each \$100.00 worth of taxable property so assessed to be credited to the General Fund of Waller County, Texas.

There shall be levied and collected upon all taxable property in Waller County for the year 2014, for the use of the County, an ad valorem tax for interest and sinking of \$.018953 on

each \$100.00 worth of taxable property so assessed to be credited to the Debt Fund of Waller County, Texas.

It shall be noted that Waller County grants a \$25,000.00 homestead exemption to persons who are sixty-five (65) year of age or older or who are disabled persons as has been previously allowed.

It shall be noted that Waller County grants an exemption of twenty percent (20%) of the appraised value of the residence homestead of Waller County residents in accordance with Tax Code Sec. 11.13(n), as amended. If this percentage produces an exemption of less than \$5,000.00 when applied to a particular residence homestead, the individual is entitled to an exemption of \$5,000.00 of the appraised value.
