DECLARATION OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the County of Waller on the 24rd day of August, 2017, there is imminent threat to widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property resulting from extended severe flooding and

WHEREAS, the County Judge of the County of Waller has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE JUDGE OF THE COUNTY OF WALLER:

That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for the County of Waller pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.


Pursuant to §418.018(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of the declaration unless continued or renewed by the Commissioners Court of Waller County.

Pursuant to §418.018(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed with the Waller County Clerk.

Pursuant to §418.018(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the Waller County Emergency Management Plan.

This this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
