**ORDER EXTENDING DECLARATION OF DISASTER**

WHEREAS, the County Judge issued a Disaster Declaration on Thursday, August 24, 2017 due to the imminent threat from Tropical Storm/Hurricane Harvey of widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property resulting from extended county-wide severe flooding; and,

WHEREAS, extraordinary measures are still necessary to alleviate the suffering of the community and to protect or rehabilitate property; and,


WHEREAS, the Waller County Commissioners' Court has determined that, due to the flooding conditions and damage from Hurricane Harvey, the Disaster Declaration should be extended; and,

WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court finds that it is appropriate to extend the Disaster Declaration.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF WALLER COUNTY:
