

Impact Based on Range of Scenario's

PRESENT RATES COST ESTIMATE	
80 Inmates / \$55 A Day	\$2,406,180 / Per Year in 2018
COST ESTIMATE (Based On)	
100 Inmates / \$60 A Day	\$3,047,528 / Per Year in 2018
COST ESTIMATE (Based On)	
100 Inmates / \$80 A Day	\$3,767,528 / Per Year in 2018
COST ESTIMATE (Based On)	
120 Inmates / \$65 A Day	\$3,776,968 / Per Year in 2018

There are no County Funds available to cover the Cost of a Jail Shut Down.

Cost must be covered from the County Maintenance and Operations Budgets:

- Resulting in reduced funds available for other County services, road repairs, and freeze on hiring personnel and buying new equipment.
- Or, tax increase of 0.05 to 0.10 (0.01 = approximately 400,000)

Once Jail is Shut Down this Cost will be incurred for 3 to 4 Years (assuming a successful future election) until a new Jail could be Built and Operational.
